

# Case Study - PolyPost

## Stokers Siding, NSW 2484

Noel Mora is a fencing contractor working in the Northern Rivers region of NSW. He installed some of the original PolyPosts in August 2019 at the height of the drought on a property at Stokers Siding and had trouble driving them into the required depth. The ground was very hard and Noel used a petrol post driver as well as a hand dolly and in both instances had difficulty installing the PolyPosts without damaging them.

In April 2020 Noel tried the PolyPost Mark II, a new and improved version with a stiffer core and steel tip. He went back to the same paddocks where he'd struggled to drive the original products and had no problems installing the new version to the required depth. Noel said "the ground was similar to where the original PolyPosts struggled and, in fact, some areas were quite compacted due to it being a vehicle track".

This time around he also used a 50mm poly pipe cut to around 1 metre as a sleeve and this assisted the installation process. The sleeve fits over the PolyPost and helps control the flexing that can occur when driven into hard ground.

Noel is happy with PolyPost Mk II is a significant improvement on the original product and is looking to use these on future electric fencing jobs.
