

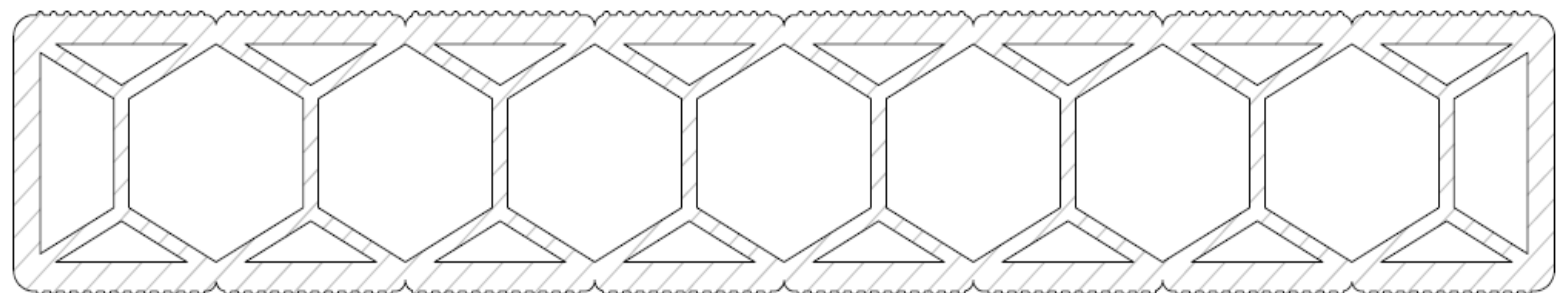
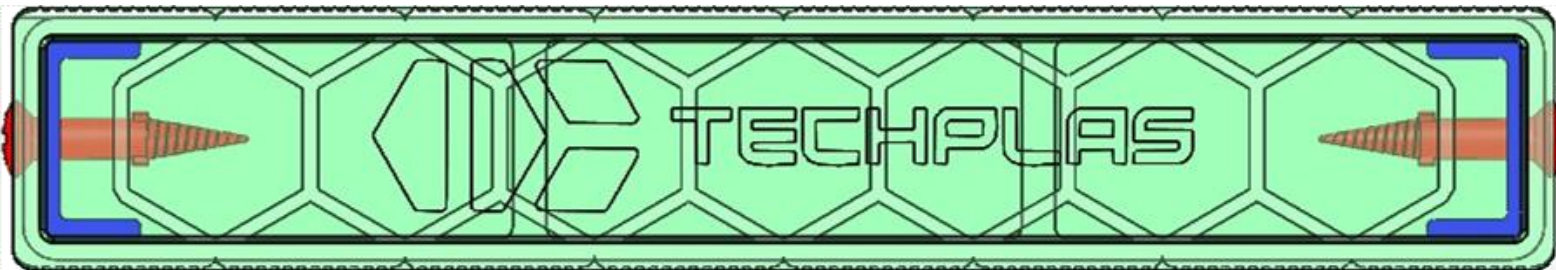

## Cost Benefit Summary

This famous adage about the importance of VALUE over PRICE could be adapted to apply to **TechBoard™ ULTRA** - the revolutionary PVC scaffold plank.

The frustration and cost of having to buy LVL scaffold planks over-and-over is eliminated with a wise investment in long-lasting TechBoard ULTRA.

The economics seems simple enough. LVL planks cost roughly half but *TechBoard ULTRA* scaffold planks can last more than to **THREE TIMES** longer. So, over a five year period a site could spend more than twice on LVL planks which are not as safe and require greater maintenance. See an example below for a site that requires 2,000 x 3 metre scaffold planks.
